The Council received the April 2010 Recreation Department report.

Motion by Phillips seconded by Grier to approve Resolution No. 21-05-10 to hire seasonal employees for the recreation department and part-time for the recreation center. Roll call: ayes; MB, DK, AG, PM, TP. Motion carried.

Motion by Phillips seconded by McGovern to authorize VJ Engineering to complete a boundary adjustment on the west side of the library site. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Bunge seconded by Kirkpatrick to approve Team Services proposal for construction testing for the new library. Roll call: ayes; MB, PM, AG, DK, nay; TP. Motion carried.

Motion by McGovern seconded by Grier to approve Loretta Hanson as the Owner's Representative for the library project with clarification on designation of authority. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Grier seconded by McGovern to decline the TIF grant request from M&G Development LLC/Dollar General Store. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by McGovern seconded by Grier to authorize Jim Jacob to adjust the plans for the drainage issue at the Child Development Center so that the permanent drain is on city property. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Grier seconded by Kirkpatrick to return the Alliant rebate to Child Development Center to be paid toward the principal of their loan. Roll call: ayes; DK, AG, nay TP, MB, abstained; PM. Motion failed.

Motion by Bunge to use the Alliant rebate for city expenses incurred on the Child Development project. Motion failed for lack of second.

Megan Grier, Ryan Striegel, and Colleen Heitmann discussed the Williamsburg 4<sup>th</sup> of July proposal with the council.

It was the consensus of the council to proceed ahead with the plans on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July.


