Motion by Kirkpatrick seconded by Grier to authorize the Police Chief, Marty Koch, to hire Brian Vercande and Patrick O'Brien as police reserves. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Kirkpatrick seconded by McGovern to allow the Kiwanis the use of the land south of the Williamsburg Recreation Center on Saturday, August 11, 2012 in order to host The Culpepper & Merriweather Circus. All ayes. Motion carried.

Garth VonAshsen informed the council that a civic organization is interested in putting a fiber glass horse in the city square by the horse trough. It was the consensus of the council to have them proceed with the project.

Garth VonAhsen also discussed the play ground equipment at the old elementary school and the possibility of a civic organization purchasing it and putting it on city property.

Motion by Grier seconded by Kirkpatrick to approve Resolution No. 24-05-12 to expand the urban renewal district. Roll call: ayes; DK, AG, DKubas, nays; PM, MB. Motion carried.


