Motion by McGovern seconded by Bunge to approve the consent agenda:

Motion by Grier seconded by McGovern to approve Resolution No. 34-09-12 hiring Lesa Waughop and Tammy Maas as front desk employees at the recreation center at the rate of \$7.50 per hour. Roll call: ayes: MB, DK, AG, PM, absent; DKubas. Motion carried.

Motion by Bunge seconded by Grier to authorize the Recreation Director to purchase a portable basketball hoop for the recreation center at a cost of \$730. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by McGovern seconded by Kirkpatrick to appoint Frank Murphy and Sandy Cronbaugh to the Iowa County Economic Development Commission. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Bunge seconded by Kirkpatrick to authorize payment of \$5,000 from hotel/motel funds to help cover the cost of installation of a sign for the Chamber of Commerce by the entrance of Tanger Outlet Center. All ayes. Motion carried.

There was a request from John Donahue to allow parking in the center of the street on the north side of the square, all facing east, bumper to bumper on September 12, 2012 from 5:30 p.m. until 8:30 p.m. The Council expressed concern for pedestrians in the street. Barricades will be available if needed.

Motion by Bunge seconded by Kirkpatrick to remove Pat McGovern and appoint Adam Grier to the landfill commission. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Kirkpatrick seconded by McGovern to allow the Williamsburg Community School District and the WHS Student Council to burn a large, upright "W" constructed by the WHS Construction Club on Thursday, September 13, 2012 for the homecoming pep rally. All ayes. Motion carried.

The Council received the Public Works Department report.

Motion by McGovern seconded by Kirkpatrick to authorize LL Pelling Co to sealcoat Sunset Avenue at a cost of \$16,636.65. Roll call: ayes; MB, PM, DK, abstained; AG, absent; DKubas. Motion carried.
