Barb Hopp, Williamsburg Chamber of Commerce informed the council about events that the Chamber plans on having for the July 4 weekend. They would like to have the Kid's Day Dance on Saturday, July 5 on the north side of the square from 7:00 p.m. until midnight. The city will get two porta-potties for the event.

There was a request from Jane Wardenburg to have the third annual vehicle fair in conjunction with their summer reading program.

John Avery, Public Works Director, informed the council of a quote from Jeff Slaymaker, to install curb and gutter on Lakeshore Drive. John will be talking to the resident that made the request to install the curb.

John informed the council that he would like to start a program where the residents could put out branches/brush at the curb and to hire Jason Kruse to chip brush/branches every couple of months for a day or so.


1. Motion by Phillips and seconded by Kirkpatrick to approve the consent agenda:

4. Motion by Phillips and seconded by Kirkpatrick to close the public hearing at 8:03 p.m. All ayes. Motion carried.
5. Motion by Phillips and seconded by Greiner to approve an ordinance to regulate the operation and use of skateboards, skates, in-line skates and manually powered scooters and other similar conveyances within the City. Roll call: ayes; MG, GV, nay; TP, DK, absent; GW. **DID NOT PASS.**

8. Motion by VonAhsen and seconded by Kirkpatrick to accept the resignation of Melinda Driscoll from the Library Board. All ayes. Motion carried.
9. Motion by Phillips and seconded by VonAhsen to advertise for the position of Assistant Recreation Director. All ayes. Motion carried.
10. Motion by Phillips and seconded by Kirkpatrick to approve the quote from Nesper Sign Advertising in the amount of \$2,607.00 for the "WILLIAMSBURG COMMUNITY RECREATION CENTER" sign for the building. All ayes. Motion carried.
11. Motion by Kirkpatrick and seconded by Phillips to authorize Electric Pump to up grade the Middle America lift station at a cost of \$37,510.00. Roll call: ayes; DK, MG, TP, nay; GV, absent; GW. Motion carried.
