1. Motion by Kirkpatrick and seconded by Wanner to approve the consent agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.



Words and phrases herein shall be construed as in the singular or plural number, and as masculine, feminine or neuter gender, according to the context.



Resolution re Alliant Energy project in property south of the Williamsburg Recreation Center.

WHEREAS, Alliant Energy is installing gas and electrical lines in an area south of the Williamsburg Recreation Center; and

WHEREAS, the City understands should the city build a structure over this area, the City shall bear the responsibility of moving those utilities into a more appropriate area.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City of Williamsburg directs the city attorney, Eric D. Tindal, to inform Alliant Energy that:


1. The City is aware of Alliant's utility project and such project's location in the area South of the Williamsburg Recreation Center.
