Mayor Armstrong and council members Murphy, Kirkpatrick, Greiner, Lortz, and Phillips were present.




1. Motion by Phillips seconded by Lortz to approve the consent agenda:

2. Motion by Phillips seconded by Lortz to approve the second reading of Ordinance No. 503 – South Trunk Sewer. Roll call: ayes; FM, TP, PL, MG, DK. Motion carried.

Motion by Phillips seconded by Lortz to suspend the rules and that all requirements of considering and voting on said ordinance at one or two council meetings prior to the meeting at which it is finally acted upon be waived and the requirement of publication of said ordinance and making copies available at the time of said publication prior to the passage be waived and that Ordinance No. 503 be immediately considered and voted upon.
